Administrative Order: 12-03

7 **WHEREAS** the Eighth Judicial District Court expects two new judicial
8 appointees to assume case adjudication in the Civil/Criminal Division by no later than
9 August 6, 2012; and,

10
11 **WHEREAS** redistribution of the existing cases in the Eighth Judicial District
12 Court Civil/Criminal Division is required to ensure equitable caseloads among all its
13 judges; and,

14 **WHEREAS** equitable caseload distribution fosters greater efficiency toward the
15 timely adjudication of cases in the Civil/Criminal Division:

16
17 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Department 25's current entire open criminal
18 caseload and current entire open specialty caseload shall be transferred to Department 7.

19 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Department 7's current entire open criminal
20 caseload shall be transferred to Department 9.

21
22 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Department 7's current entire open civil
23 caseload be transferred as follows: 250 cases to Department 25 and the remainder to
24 Department 14.

25 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Department 14's current entire open criminal
26 and civil caseloads, with the exception of municipal court appeals, shall be transferred to
27 Department 25.

28 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that 325 cases aged 48 months or less from
Department 26's current open civil caseload shall be transferred to Department 14.

1 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that 325 cases aged 48 months or less from
2 Department 27's current open civil caseload shall be transferred to Department 14.

3 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that 325 cases aged 48 months or less from
4 Department 31's current open civil caseload be transferred to Department 14.
5

6 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that 75 cases from Department 13's current open
7 civil caseload, excluding business court cases, shall be transferred to Department 14.

8 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that 75 cases from Department 29's current open
9 civil caseload, excluding business court cases, shall be transferred to Department 14.
10

11 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that 100 cases from Department 32's current open
12 civil caseload, excluding foreclosure mediation petitions for judicial review, shall be
13 transferred to Department 4.

14 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the aforementioned transfers shall take effect
15 on August 6, 2012.
