IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE MATTER OF ELECTION-RELATED MATTERS FILED ON NOVEMBER 5, 2024

Administrative Order: 24-07

WHEREAS, the Eighth Judicial District Court, as part of the state constitutional judicial system, "has the inherent power to protect itself and to administer its affairs." *City of N. Las Vegas ex rel. Arndt v. Daines*, 92 Nev. 292, 294, 550 P.2d 399, 400 (1976); and,

WHEREAS, the Chief Judge is responsible for supervising the administrative business of the Eighth Judicial District Court, ensuring the quality and continuity of its services, supervising its calendar, reassigning cases as convenience or necessity requires, assuring the court's duties are timely and orderly performed and otherwise facilitate the business of the District Court. NRS 3.025; see also EDCR 1.30(b).

WHEREAS, the general election is Tuesday, November 5, 2024 ("Election Day"). By this order, the court intends to prepare for the possibility that actions pertaining to the election process may be filed during or after regular business hours and further intends to implement a fair and expeditious process by which election-related actions can be heard and adjudicated through the end of Election Day.

The court deems it in the best interests of justice to extend its hours of operation and designate three judges within the Eighth Judicial District Court to serve as Election Day judges to ensure the fair and expeditious resolution of all election-related actions filed on Election Day.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, pursuant to EDCR 1.30(12) and EDCR 1.30(14), concurrently with and in addition to its regular business hours, the Clerk's Office shall be open between 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. on Election Day to process the filing of election-related actions. Litigants are encouraged to submit filings electronically. Questions regarding election-related filings may be directed to the Clerk's Office at (702) 671-0622.

 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, pursuant to EDCR 1.30(15), EDCR 1.30(16) and EDCR 1.30(17), the district court judges in Departments 5, 6 and 9 will serve on a special committee designated to individually preside, on a randomly-generated rotational basis, over any election-related actions filed beginning at 7:00 a.m. on November 5, 2024 and ending at 12:00 a.m. on November 6, 2024.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, pursuant to EDCR 1.30(10) and EDCR 1.30(15), each election-related action filed between 7:00 a.m. on November 5, 2024 and 12:00 a.m. on November 6, 2024, shall be randomly assigned to Departments 5, 6 and 9, that each Department receiving a random assignment shall be excluded from subsequent assignments until all three departments have drawn an election-related action, at which time the random assignment process shall begin anew.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, pursuant to EDCR 1.30(13) and EDCR 1.30(15), any election-related actions filed before or after Election Day shall be randomly assigned to any district court judge.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, pursuant to EDCR 1.30(13) and EDCR 1.30(15), the Clerk's Office shall take the steps reasonably necessary to preserve the integrity of the aforementioned assignment process and a representative from court administration shall witness each random assignment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, pursuant to EDCR 1.30(13) and EDCR 1.30(15), the court encourages litigants intending to file election-related actions to include the terms "Election-Related Action" in the caption of the pleading to help assure the proper designation of their actions as election-related actions. The term "Election-Related Action" shall be construed liberally to include all matters touching upon the facilitation and integrity of the 2024 general election.
