Attention Nevada Attorneys:

Do I Need a Subscription Account?

After recently receiving approval from the Nevada Supreme Court, District Court is taking over the responsibility for the overall administration of public access through a single portal with access to all case types. The court plans to change the remote access fee from the current monthly or annual fee to a lower annual flat fee that will save users money. Access to view electronic documents will still be available at no cost at the Clerk's Office and to permit anyone to order copies of documents in accordance with NRS 19.013.

If you are an Attorney in good standing with the State Bar of Nevada, you can register for subscription access. Subscription accounts give attorneys the ability to view and download all publicly available documents for an annual flat fee. Elevated access is available for attorneys of record, with the ability to view certain sealed cases and documents.

The schedule of charges for this elevated access is:

1 user	\$100.00 annually.
2 – 5 users	\$200.00 annually.
6 – 10 users	\$350.00 annually.

Due to the transition from multiple platforms there will be no charge for public access subscription accounts in 2016. More information will be provided when the annual renewal period begins for 2017.

How do I Apply for a Subscription Account?

Step 1 – Register for an account
