IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE MATTER OF SPECIALTY COURT CASE REASSIGNMENTS

Administrative Order: 25-02

WHEREAS, the Chief Judge is responsible for supervising the administrative business of the Eighth Judicial District Court, ensuring the quality and continuity of its services, supervising its calendar, reassigning cases as convenience or necessity requires, assuring the court's duties are timely and orderly performed, and otherwise facilitating the business of the Court; NRS 3.025; see also EDCR 1.30(b);

WHEREAS, the Court operates several specialty court programs pursuant to NRS 176A.065, including Veterans Treatment Court over which Department 23 currently presides, and Mental Health Court over which Department 1 currently presides; and,

WHEREAS, Administrative Order 16-12 prescribes the circumstances under which hearing masters may oversee specialty court matters and specifically affords each party the opportunity to be heard before a District Judge regarding remands and termination from the program.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, pursuant to EDCR 1.30(b), that Veterans Treatment Court shall be reassigned from Department 23 to Department 1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, pursuant to EDCR 1.30(b), that Hearing Master Roys shall, under the direction and oversight of Department 1 and subject to the provisions in Administrative Order 16-12, incorporated herein by reference, preside over the Mental Health Court calendar.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, pursuant to EDCR 1.30(b), that the aforementioned reassignments shall take effect on February 10, 2025.
